Program Overview

The Master in Development Management (MDM) Program is a practitioner-oriented program designed to equip development executives and practitioners, and leaders of faith-based communities and other non-profit organizations for effective leadership and management of development programs and civil society institutions for holistic transformation.

Admission Requirements:

- 1) Four year undergraduate degree or equivalent;
- 2) At least six years full-time work experience with 3 years at a supervisory or managerial level;
- 3) Experience in development projects or institution is beneficial; and
- 4) Proficiency in oral and written English

MDM ISP 2012 Training Venue:

The venue for the MDM ISP 2012 is at Bing's HUB Retreat Center, #30 Dominican Road, Baguio City, Philippines. Baguio City is the summer capital of the Philippines and has many tourist attractions. It is just 2-3 hour drive from amazing tourist spots like the Hundred Islands in Pangasinan, historical Spanish Houses of Vigan City, awesome Mt. Pinatubo Crater Lake, and majestic Banaue Rice Terraces. It is also just 2-3 hours flight from the newly proclaimed 7 Natural Wonders of the World – Puerto Princesa Underground River, Boracay Island – one of the world's best beaches, Bohol's Chocolate Hills, and perfectly-coned Mayon Volcano.

Note: 1) SOAR refers to Students' Orientation And Retreat; SWEAR means Students' Wrap Up, Evaluation & Reflection.

2) MDM students have two Options, i.e. Plan A involves taking 2 Elective courses plus a Comprehensive Examination after completing all 15 courses; or Plan B means taking 1 Elective course plus the Management Research Course.

3) MDM graduation requirement is either a Comprehensive Examination for those taking Plan A or a Management Research Paper (MRP) as final output from the Management Research course for those taking Plan B.

Accreditation

The Master in Development Management (MDM) Program of ASDECS is accredited by the International Council for Higher Education (ICHE) based in Switzerland.

MDM ISP 2012 Training Fees

Fees include the following:

- i) Tuition Fees of \$400 per course or subject for a total of \$2,000 for the 5 courses to be taken up in ISP 2012! But you get a DISCOUNT of 15% if you enrol and pay your Full Tuition Fees on or before April 30, 2012. If you enrol and pay your full Tuition Fees on or before May 31, 2012, you get a DISCOUNT of 10%. Those who enrol and pay beginning June 1, 2012 will get no discount from Tuition Fees. Tuition Fees inclusive of training materials.
- ii) Board & Lodging Fee covering 3 meals and 2 snacks plus a twin-sharing room is \$25 per person or \$950 for 38 days. Laundry services are available in nearby laundry shops at reasonable rates.
- iii) Miscellaneous Fee of \$200 covering the following: a) ASDECS Graduate Admission Fee of \$25; b) Fee for a one day Students' Orientation & Retreat (SOAR) is \$75; and c) Fee for a 2.5 day Students' Wrap Up, Evaluation & Reflection (SWEAR) is \$100.

Note: Fees do NOT include transportation expenses from your place of origin to training venue and back.
